Normal and excess rainfall in 89% of country: IMD

New Delhi : Around 89% of the country has received "normal" and "excess" rainfall, the India Meteorological Department said. The 11% of areas that received "deficient" rainfall include Gujarat, Assam, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram, and Tripura, among others. Several parts of Gujarat recorded a rainfall deficiency of 58%, while the east and the northeast region of the country reached a rainfall deficiency of 21%.

He said concerned persons have to work as a team to improve the quality of education system. The Minister said, teachers should encourage the students to dream big and give them life skills, technical skills and high values.

Ministry of Health launches Nationwide "Intensified Diarrhoea Control Fortnight (IDCF)"

New Delhi : On the directions of the Minister of Health and Family Welfare, Shri J P Nadda, Ministry of Health launched nationwide "Intensified Diarrhoea Control Fortnight (IDCF)", here today. The Intensified Diarrhoea Control Fortnight (IDCF) will be observed from 11th to 23rd July across the country. The Ministry also unveiled a package of measures putting the Government's resolve to end child diarrhoea deaths on the overdrive.

As directed by the Health Minister Shri J P Nadda to reach out to the under-five children, the timing of the programme is very critical as this is just the onset of monsoon and diarrhoea is beginning to show up. Various activities shall form part of this fortnight. ASHAs shall visit all households with children below five years of age for pre-positioning the ORS. They shall also explain the benefits of these. The importance of this activity is that ORS will be available in the household when needed at the time of diarrhea. It is often observed that during critical stages of diarrhoea, ORS is not available in the households. Secondly, all health facilities shall have ORS corners which shall continuously demonstrate the way to prepare the ORS mixture. These corners will also administer ORS and Zinc to children

who are in need of these during diarrhoea. With a sharpened focus on demand generation, an important component of the IDCF is IEC activities that shall not only create awareness but also generate demand. Intensified community awareness campaigns on hygiene and promotion of ORS and Zinc therapy will be conducted at the state, district and village levels.

There are about 10 crore children below five years of age across the country. During last year, due to the interventions carried out as part of IDCF, about 6.3 crore children were reached out to. This year in order to expand the cover of this fortnight, the target is to cover all the under-5 children. 21 Lakh children could be prevented from hospitalisation and death due to Diarrhoea last year. More than 5 lakh schools participated in the IDCF campaign and more than 3.5 lakh ORS corners were set up in the country. In order to ensure a sturdy mechanism for monitoring, this year, 23 national monitors shall assess the efficacy of the activities. This shall be complemented by monitors from the State governments and development partners.

The combination of ORS and Zinc has been found to be the most cost-effective intervention to prevent deaths due to diarrhea and has been recognised as one of the best practices globally.

Radhika Menon: First woman to receive Award for Exceptional Bravery at Sea

New Delhi : Radhika Menon will become the first woman in the world to receive the Award for Exceptional Bravery at Sea from the International Maritime Organisation for saving the lives of seven fishermen, whose hopes of survival were all but over.

Menon was at the helm of oil tanker 'Sampurna Swarajya' of Shipping Corporation of India.

She is the first woman captain of the Indian Merchant Navy.. and will be the first female to receive the Award for Exceptional Bravery at Sea.

Indian Embassy assures stranded Indians of all possible help

New Delhi : The Indian embassy in South Sudan has asked Indians stranded in Juba to stay calm, assuring them that they are in constant touch with authorities in India. The Embassy in a statement said, all options are being considered to provide relief to them.

Heavy fighting between South Sudan's army and former rebels was witnessed on Sunday in the capital city of Juba as both sides exchanged fire in several parts of the city. Bhupat Patel, an Indian resident in

South Sudan, tweeted to External Affairs Minister Sushma Swaraj asking for help, saying that they are stuck in between the heavy gunfire.

Mrs Swaraj retweeted the Indian embassy's statement and said that concerned authorities have been intimated to extend help.

The violence comes a day after the world's youngest country marked its fifth independence anniversary.

India reports 26 crimes against women every hour

New Delhi : Twenty-six crimes against women are reported every hour in India, or one complaint every two minutes, as per a report by IndiaSpend. With 169.6 crimes per 100,000 population of women, Delhi has the highest crime rate in the country. In terms of absolute numbers, Uttar Pradesh had over 38,000 crimes against women registered, most in the country.

Precise monsoon information to farmers by 2019

New Delhi : Indian and British scientists are working on a project under the National Monsoon Mission to provide precise information about monsoon to all farmers up to the block-level by 2019. Only 1.13 crore out of 9.30 crore farmers get monsoon information till now, said Union Minister Harsh Vardhan. Under this, India will manufacture an atmospheric research aircraft within two years.

Road safety highest priority, US assures all help: Gadkari

Mr. Gadkari said the US has assured cooperation with the rules, regulations, the software technology, road safety and intelligent traffic management. He is on a visit to the United States aimed at attracting FDI in the crucial infrastructure sector in India and accelerating bilateral cooperation with the US.

PM returns home after concluding his four-nation visit to Africa

New Delhi : Prime Minister Narendra Modi returned home this morning after concluding his 4-nation visit to Africa. The visit covered Mozambique, South Africa, Tanzania and Kenya. Before leaving Kenyan capital Nairobi last night, Mr Modi tweeted in Swahili, the country's local language. He said, his visit to Kenya was memorable and has made the economic and cultural relations between the two countries more consistent.

Mr Modi also addressed the joint meeting of Indian and Kenyan business leaders. He said, India will work to reduce the trade imbalance with Kenya and assured the African nation that the effort would be to strengthen its processes and enrich its resources.

Kenyan President Uhuru Kenyatta was also present at the meeting.

The Prime Minister told the business delegates that India is the fastest growing large economy

globally and is improving its ranking in various global indicators considerably. Mr Modi said, India is Kenya's largest trading partner and second largest investor and will enhance its investment in Kenya more rapidly.

AIR correspondent, who covered the Prime Minister's tour, reports the visit was remarkable for imparting a renewed energy to India's engagement with Africa which started with the India Africa Forum Summit last year.

During the visit, India signed a number of agreements and MoUs in fields covering IT, Infrastructure, Mining, Defence and maritime security, Food security and agro industries, health care among many others.

In his interaction with the diaspora community in all these countries, the Prime Minister made a forceful appeal to them to come and explore the economic opportunities offered by

Govt to set up panel to chalk out a long-term strategy to tackle shortage of pulses

New Delhi : Government has decided to set up a panel to chalk out a long-term strategy to tackle the shortage of pulses in the country. The committee, to be headed by Chief Economic Advisor, will consider reasonable hike in minimum support price of pulses and also bonus for the farmers. It will submit its report within two weeks.

The decision was taken at a high-level meeting held in New Delhi yesterday. The meeting, chaired by Finance Minister Arun Jaitley, reviewed the availability pulses and their prices. It was also decided to increase the buffer stock of pulses from 8 lakh to 20 lakh tonnes. The meeting was informed that the pulses production this year is expected to reach 200 lakh tonnes mark and it will

significantly increase its availability in the domestic market.

During the discussion, there was concern over high price of chana dal and it was felt that states should take strict action to ensure its availability at reasonable prices as there is no shortage of the commodities.

Food Minister Ram Vilas Paswan, who attended the meeting, offered more pulses to states. Tur will be given to states at 66 rupees per Kilogram and Urad 82 rupees per Kg to sold on retail not exceeding 120 rupees per Kg.

The meeting was also attended by Information and Broadcasting Minister Venkaiah Naidu.

Monsoon all set to cover the entire nation in next 24 hours

New Delhi : The monsoon is all set to cover the entire nation in the next 24 hours. Southwest Monsoon has already covered 90 per cent of the country's geographical area till yesterday, barring some parts of western Rajasthan and Kutch region. Director, Indian Meteorological Department, B P Yadav told AIR that monsoon will reach these two regions in a day.

Met department has forecast an above normal

monsoon this year bringing cheer across the board, from industry to farmers. AIR correspondent says that it has boosted market sentiments.

The above normal monsoon this year has brought a smile on the face of farmers and industrialists as well. Sowing of kharif crop in the country has picked up fast and has crossed over four lakh hectare. Rice has been

Addressing a program in Lucknow, the chief general manager of NABARD, AK Panda said that as of now 74 lakh Self help groups, SHGs, covering over ten crore families have been financed by NABARD in the country.

A total of Rupees 11482 crores were disbursed to the people and agencies in Uttar Pradesh in FY 2015-16, he said. In Uttar Pradesh the number of SHGs is four lakhs and fifty lakh families. He said that

130 producer's organization assisted by NABARD was being run in UP out of which 100 have turned into full fledged companies doing robust businesses. Through Tribal Development Fund of NABARD, 8500 Tribal families in three districts of UP- Sonbhadra, Jhansi and Lalitpur are being served by enhancing their livelihood conditions.

AIR correspondent reports that NABARD is also carrying out financial literacy programs in five hundred districts including sixty districts of UP. In the main program, exhibition was also held where women pertaining to

different SHGs also showcased their products and told their tales of triumphs.

The NABARD acts as a catalyst as it coordinates with banks and regional cooperative banks for the betterment of rural people and its infrastructure through lending credit through various banks. The organization is also providing direct help to get geographical Indicators GI tags to their region specific produces. Besides, NABARD is also in dialogue with IRCTC to participate in its catering services where the SHGs will provide standardised food items to the passengers.

India planning evacuation of nationals from South Sudan: Sushma Swaraj

New Delhi : In her tweet External Affairs Minister Sushma Swaraj urged people to register themselves with Indian Embassy and do not panic. She advised Indian nationals not to travel to South Sudan.

Renewed gunfights broke out on Sunday across South Sudan's capital

between forces loyal to the president and those of the vice president causing widespread casualties.

The spokesperson of the Vice president said the country is returning to civil war, UN Mission in South Sudan is on a high security alert with no movement of UN personnel whatsoever.

The fighting is a resumption of the conflict on Friday in which more than 100 people died. UN Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon condemned the senseless violence. The UN Security Council is holding an emergency session to discuss South Sudan.

SHOW CAUSE NOTICE

WHEREAS, Smt. T.T. Nasila, Aquarium Keeper, Marine Aquarium & Museum (under Suspension), Department of Fisheries (District Panchayat), Kavaratti entered on Child Care Leave for 25 days with effect from 20.10.2014, which was sanctioned vide Order F.No.6/2/2012-Fy-(DP) dated 26.11.2014.

And WHEREAS, Disciplinary Proceedings was initiated against Smt. T.T. Nasila, Aquarium Keeper, Marine Aquarium & Museum for misappropriation of Govt. money, and the Competent Authority had placed her under suspension with effect from 27.11.2014 vide Order F.No.63/1/2012-Fy-(DP) dated 27.11.2014, with direction not to leave Headquarters without permission, and extending the period of suspension from time to time according to rules in force.

AND WHEREAS, Smt. T.T. Nasila, had applied for extension of leave vide letter dated 5.11.2014. The same has not been sanctioned by the Copetent Authority and direction was issued to Smt. T.T. Nasila to report at Headquarter (HQ), Kavaratti vide Order F.No.6/2/2012-Fy-(DP) dated 05.12.2014. The official did not report for duty in time and she failed to stay at HQ i.e. kavaratti despite the fact that Authority has not considered her request to change the Headquarter. Subsequently, Show Cause Notice was issued to this effect vide Order F.No.7/3/2014-Fy dated 17.04.2015.

AND WHEREAS, despite repeated Show Cause Notice/Memorandums and directions from Director of Fisheries and District Fisheries Officer, Smt. T.T. Nasila has not replied and reported only once i.e. on 24.4.2015 and, left Headquarter again, without permission from the Competent Authority.

AND WHEREAS Smt. T.T. Nasila, despite knowing the fact that her Headquarters had been fixed at Kavaratti and that, her request for change of Headquarter has not been allowed, has continued to take the plea that she has not been receiving any of the notices for extension of suspension or for reporting back to Headquarter, a claim which exposes the fact that, she is not in Headquarters.

AND WHEREAS, the absence of Smt. T.T. Nasila from Kavaratti HQ without permission is further proved by the fact that, she has, received correspondences from the department on 19.5.2015 at Kalpeni, this being corroborated by the departmental records, ie. acknowledgement due, card of Department of Posts signed at Kalpeni by Smt. T. T. Nasila on 19.5.2015. Further, the receipt of correspondance on 19.5.2015 has been admitted by her in her letter dated 30.9.2015.

AND WHEREAS, the absence of Smt. T.T. Nasila from Kavaratti HQ without permission during the period of suspension, as well as her action of not responding to the departmental notices/directions is a conduct unbecoming of a public servant and demonstrate dereliction, negligence in discharge of duties as well as insubordination.

NOW THEREFORE, Smt. T.T. Nasila, Aquarium Keeper, Marine Aquarium & Museum (under Suspension), is hereby direct to Show Cause as to why the Disciplinary Proceedings should not be initiated against you for dereliction/negligence in discharging your duty, insubordination, and conduct unbecoming of a Government Servant, Smt. T.T. Nasila is hereby directed to submit reply if any, within 15 days, failing which it will be presumed that she has nothing to say/submit in this regard and, action will not be taken as per CCS (CCA) Rules, 1965.
