Top Stories Centre to eliminate malaria by 2030: JP Nadda

New Delhi : The government has set the target of eliminating malaria by 2030 after neighbouring countries like Sri Lanka and Nepal reported no deaths due to the vector-borne disease in the past several years.

Launching the National Framework for Malaria Elimination (2016-2030) in New Delhi Union Health Minister J P Nadda said 70 per cent of malaria cases and 69 per cent of malaria deaths among South East Asian Region countries, occur in India.

Govt. may announce new bulk drug policy: Hansraj Ahir

New Delhi : Union Minister of State for Chemicals and Fertilisers Hansraj Ahir has said that the government may announce the new bulk drug policy in a month's time.

The policy is expected to bring down imports. Speaking on the sidelines of Make in India week in Mumbai, he said the new bulk drug policy will also increase the domestic output.

India successfully test-fires indigenously developed Prithvi II missile from Chandipur

New Delhi : India today successfully test fired its indigenously developed Prithvi-II missile from the Chandipur, off Odisha coast. The medium range missile is capable of carrying 500 kg to 1000 kg of warheads and is thrusted by liquid propulsion twin engines.

As part of a user trial, the missile with a strike range of 350 km, the surface-to-surface Prithvi-II test was carried out from a mobile launcher from launch complex-3 of the Integrated Test Range at around 1030 hrs.

The first missile to be developed by DRDO under India's Integrated Guided Missile Development Program, Prithvi-II was inducted into India's armed forces in 2003. The last user trial of Prithvi-II was successfully conducted on November 26, 2015 from the same test range in Odisha.

PM asks Ministers to complete projects within deadline

New Delhi : Prime Minister Shri. Narendra Modi has advised his Council of Ministers to ensure projects were completed within the timeframe and due publicity given to the achievements of the government. Addressing his Council of Ministers in New Delhi yesterday evening, Mr. Modi said the deadlines, especially of social sector schemes, are sacrosanct and should not be missed at any cost. He said, when government announces a scheme, it increases the expectations of the people.

The Prime Minister showed keen interest in the

progress made in his pet project Swachh Bharat Abhiyan. He also suggested organising 'Urja Divas' in villages and other places electrified after many years.

Presentations were also made on Swachh Bharat Mission, housing for all by 2022, Atal pension scheme, Prime Minister Jeevan Suraksha, Jan Dhan Yojna, Skill Development Scheme, setting up of six IIMs, three AIIMS and six IITs and the newly enacted Juvenile Justice law.

Home Minister Shri. Rajnath Singh, Defence

Minister Shri. Manohar Parrikar, Food Processing Minister Shri. Harsimrat Kaur, Health Minister Shri. J. P Nadda and Science and Technology Minister Shri. Harsh Vardhan were among the prominent ministers present at the meeting.
