National Emergency Response System to be launched soon: Govt

New Delhi : A National Emergency Response System is soon to be launched in the country. It seeks to connect police with the citizens. The proposed system will also include ambulance and fire brigade services. Minister of State for Home Haribhai P. Chaudhary stated this in the Lok Sabha today. He said it will be funded and implemented by the Centre in association with the States and Union Territories.

Sandeep Tomar qualifies for Rio Olympics

New Delhi : Tomar secured the spot by winning a bronze in the freestyle 57 kg category at the World Qualifying Tournament in Ulaanbaatar in Mongolia on Sunday.

He defeated opponent Alexandru Chirtoaca 10-0 in the face-off to decide the bronze medal winner. The 25 year old wrestler has previously won gold medals at the 2016 Asian Wrestling Championships and the 2013 Commonwealth Wrestling Championship.

MoU executed to implement Health Insurance Package for the residents of Lakshadweep

Kavaratti : An MoU has been signed between New India Assurance Co.Ltd and Lakshadweep Administration for implementing Health Insurance package for the residents of Lakshadweep on 26th April 2016 in the presence of Hon'ble Administrator Shri. Vijay Kumar, IAS and Member of Parliament Shri. P.P. Mohammed Faizal at Secretariat Conference Hall. Dr.K.P. Hamzakoya, DHS on behalf of Lakshadweep Administration and Shri. Rajashekar, GM, on

behalf of Newe India Assurance Company signed the MoU.

The actual implementation of the project will commence from 60 days of signing the MoU. This will be a milestone in the field of health care delivery system in Lakshadweep Islands. The Scheme will be benefitted approximately 5355 families (22000 people) who belong to AAY, BPL, PHH etc. The main idea of the scheme is to provide the quality medical care for the people of Lakshadweep

requiring specialised treatment up to Rs. 2.00 Lakh per year per family for ordinary diseases and Rs. 3.00 Lakh per year per family in certain critical illness in any of the empanelled hospital in Ernakulam, Kozhikode and Mangalore regions where the islanders usually go for medical treatment on cashless basis through Health Insurance Card.

All the head of the Departments and Officers from New India Assurance Company Ltd were present on the occasion.

India-Pakistan Foreign Secretaries hold bilateral talks on range of issues in Delhi

New Delhi : Foreign Secretaries of India and Pakistan today held bilateral talks focusing on a range of issues. It is the first such formal meeting between the two top diplomats after talks were deferred in January following the attack by Pakistani terrorists at Pathankot Airbase. In a statement, Ministry of External Affairs spokesperson said, the discussions between the Foreign Secretaries were frank and constructive and both sides raised issues of concern to them.

Mr. Jaishankar emphasised the need for early progress on Pathankot terror attack investigation as well as 26/11 Mumbai terror attack case trial in Pakistan. He also brought up the listing of Jaish e Mohammed leader Masood Azhar in UN Sanctions Committee. He clearly conveyed that Pakistan cannot be in denial on the impact of terrorism on the bilateral relationship. The Foreign Secretary said, terrorist groups based in Pakistan targeting India must not

be allowed to operate with impunity.

India also pressed for immediate consular access to Kulbhushan Jadhav, former Naval officer abducted and taken to Pakistan. The Pakistan Foreign Secretary is in New Delhi on a day-long visit to attend the Senior Officials Meeting of the Heart of Asia - Istanbul Process. Earlier, Mr. Jaishankar met Afghan Deputy Foreign Minister Hekmat Karzai and discussed issues of mutual interests.

President embarks on two-nation tour to Papua New Guinea and New Zealand

New Delhi : President Pranab Mukherjee leaves New Delhi for a two Nation tour to Papua New Guinea and New Zealand this evening. The Minister of State for Agriculture Dr. Sanjeev Kumar Balyan and three Members of Parliament would be accompanying the President for the visit. This is the first ever state visit of an Indian President to these two countries.

Symbolizing the growing strategic and economic engagements with the Pacific Island countries, the President's first stopover will be Port Moresby, the capital of Papua New Guinea. He would be holding talks with the Governor General Michael Ogio and Prime Minister Peter O'Neil among others.

The President will also interact with the

business community and the Indian diaspora. Papua New Guinea is looking towards increasing cooperation in health sector, IT, agriculture and infrastructure. The visit is likely to brighten up the prospects of Indian pharmaceutical companies in the Pacific nation after the local government withdrew a ban three months ago.

In the second leg of his visit, the President would be arriving at Auckland, New Zealand on Saturday. Cooperation between India and New Zealand has been on the rise over the years in various fields. The President will be holding talks with the Governor General, the Prime Minister and the leader of opposition. He would also address the Indian community and a business forum.

PM calls to bridge gap between urban and rural areas by ensuring modern day facilities

New Delhi : Prime Minister Narendra Modi has emphasised the need for bridging the gap between cities and rural areas by ensuring that all modern day facilities reach even the far off places.

Addressing a function on the culmination of 10-day 'Gram Uday Se Bharat Uday' campaign at Jamshedpur in Jharkhand yesterday, Mr. Modi said, the country's progress

depends hugely on the development of villages. He called for strengthening democracy at the grassroots level, saying gram sabhas are as important as Parliament.

The Prime Minister asked the gram panchayats to play an active role in developmental activities, taking advantage of the immense resources and schemes of the government.

Ceasefire between India with NSCN(R) extended for a year

New Delhi : The ceasefire between Government of India with National Socialist Council of Nagaland (Reformation), NSCN(R) has been extended for one year from tomorrow.

An agreement in this regard was signed by Joint Secretary in the Ministry of Home Affairs Satyendra Garg and Imlongnukshi Chang and Kavishe Sumi on behalf of NSCN(R).

Paris agreement historic achievement for mankind: Javadekar

New Delhi : Minister of State for Environment, Forest and Climate Change Prakash Javadekar has described the Paris agreement a historical achievement for mankind saying that countries should implement it in letter and spirit. Addressing the Major Economies Forum in New York, Mr. Javadekar said, with signing of the historic agreement, developed world needs to immediately ratify the Kyoto Protocol 2nd commitment period and should present enhanced pre-2020 actions.

He said, early fulfillment of 100 billion dollar per year mobilisation by developed

countries is important, because without means of implementation, many countries' Intended Nationally Determined Contributions will not be fructified. He said, pre-2020 actions of developed countries should be in accordance with the principles and provisions of the convention. Mr Javadekar said, it should be comprehensive which includes all relevant sources and reservoirs of green house gases, and adaptation as well as finance, technology development and transfer, including cost effective technologies.

Country's coastal area secured against any terrorist infiltration: Govt in LS

New Delhi : The government informed the Lok Sabha today that the entire coastal area of the country has been secured against any terrorist infiltration. Answering a question Minister of State for Home Kiren Rijju said a three-tier security ring has been put in place by the State Marine Police, Indian Coast Guard and the Navy.

The Indian Navy patrols along the International Maritime Boundary Line and the Coast Guard has been

mandated to keep surveillance in India's Exclusive Economic Zone extending up to 200 nautical miles. The State Marine Police patrols the shallow coastal areas.

In addition, there are 45 radar stations and 74 automatic identification stations to stop terrorist infiltration. Registration of sea-going vessels and identification of persons on board have been made compulsory, Mr. Rijju said.

102 villages electrified last week, total 7,445 lighten up till date

New Delhi : 102 villages have been electrified across the country during last week under Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Gram Jyoti Yojna. Out of these electrified villages, 32 in Assam, 23 villages belong to Arunachal Pradesh, 11 in Jharkhand, 13 in Bihar, 6 in Odisha, 7 in Madhya Pradesh, 3 in Rajasthan, 2 in Chhattisgarh, 2 in Manipur and 3 in Uttar Pradesh.

Government has decided to electrify remaining more than 18 thousand unelectrified villages by May, 2018. Prime Minister Narendra Modi's in his address to the nation on Independence Day last year had mentioned about it. Power Ministry in a release said, 7,445 villages have been electrified till date.

ICMR, Sun Pharma join hands for research in preventive health

New Delhi : Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) and Sun Pharma have entered into an agreement for research and innovation in preventive health. This was announced by Union Health Minister JP Nadda in New Delhi at a function on the occasion of World Malaria Day yesterday.

He said, this unique initiative is a significant step in the health sector and reiterated the commitment of the government to strengthen health research in the country. He said this collaboration, which is India's first public-private-partnership for research and innovation, will prove to be a milestone in the government's strategy to address the issue of Malaria in the country.

In addition, ICMR and Sun Pharma will jointly conduct scientific research for development and testing of medical products including drugs, biosimilars and vaccines as well as undertake disease control and elimination programs. They will setup a Joint Working Group to identify and collaborate in disease surveillance and elimination that are relevant to India.

Both will expand cooperation in the area of translational health sciences research with the objective of developing new and improved medicines for infectious and chronic diseases. They will jointly work to strengthen capacity and facilities required for conducting research and trials aimed at testing safety and efficacy of medical products.

Need to develop transport corridor in South Asia: B'desh envoy

New Delhi : Bangladesh High Commissioner to India Syed Muazzem Ali has emphasised the need to develop transport corridors to promote trade and economic cooperation with India and other South Asian countries. Mr. Syed Muazzem Ali said this while addressing the Economic Cooperation

Dialogue in Eastern South Asia organised by the United Nation Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific (UNESCAP) in Shillong yesterday.

He said, Bangladesh is keen to restore the connectivity that have been there with the north-eastern States of India.

He said, Railways and river connectivity are considered the best as they are least expensive, most ecological and most economic viable. Mukul Sangma said that identified trade corridors need to have proper connectivity infrastructure.

Countdown for launch of navigation satellite IRNSS-1G begins

New Delhi : The 51-and-a-half hour countdown for the launch of India's seventh navigation satellite IRNSS 1G on board the launch vehicle PSLV C33 has begun this morning at 9.20 hrs at the Satish Dhawan Space Centre, Sriharikotta. The satellite is the final in the series of space fleet to establish India's own space technology-based navigation system to aid the air, maritime and surface transport.

The ISRO scientists have said, filling up of liquid fuel in the fourth stage of the launch

vehicle PSLV C33 is going on now as part of the countdown process. Indian Regional Navigation Satellites System is aimed at self-reliance in space based navigation.

The satellite IRNSS 1G is similar in configuration to its six other peer satellites which are now in space. The rocket PSLV C33 with the passenger on board will undertake the journey in its extended version with strap on boosters, given the passenger satellite's weight and the orbital destination.

Sharing competitive exam scores with private sector

New Delhi : The Government has approved the policy for public disclosure of scores and ranking of the candidates who appear for recruitment examinations conducted by various public recruitment agencies for the benefit of employers in the public and private sector seeking qualified candidates through a portal.

The Union Public Service Commission

(UPSC) has given some observations in this regard that have been communicated to the concerned authorities. This was stated by the Minister of State for Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions and Minister of State in the Prime Minister's Office Dr. Jitendra Singh in a written reply to a question by Shri Vinayak Bhaurao Raut and Shri Rahul Shewale in the Lok Sabha today.

Startup India launched to build strong eco-system for nurturing innovation: Heptulla

New Delhi : Minority Affairs Minister Dr. Najma Heptulla today said the Startup India programme has been launched to build a strong eco-system for nurturing innovation and Startups in the country. Replying to supplementaries in the Lok Sabha Dr. Heptulla said the programme aims at empowering Startups to grow through innovation and design.

She said the government will provide financial support to young scientists for purchasing equipment for innovation under it. The Minister also informed that Stand Up India scheme which was launched on 5th of this month aims at facilitating bank loans to persons belonging to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and women for setting up a Greenfield enterprise in

trading in services and manufacturing. She said under this programme, loans in the range of 10 lakh to one crore rupees are being provided. The Minister also informed that the corpus of National Minorities Development and Finance Corporation has been doubled to 3000 crores rupees.

Shri Gadkari says a positive approach and fast decision making must for achieving targets

New Delhi : The Minister for Road Transport & Highways & Shipping Shri. Nitin Gadkari has emphasized that a positive attitude, transparent working system and prompt decision making are essential for the Ministry to realize its objective of facilitating safe and seamless travel across the country. He was inaugurating a conference of Regional Officers of NHAI in New Delhi today. Shri Gadkari said that officials should try to solve problems in a proactive and positive manner within the ambit of applicable rules and regulations, and avoid unnecessary delays. He said that negative approach only leads to delay in the completion of project, and delays cause avoidable cost overruns and harassment to all stakeholders. The Minister emphasized on cooperation, coordination and communication as the key to find solutions. He stressed that there should be proper

delegation of work in conformity with management best practices and effort should be on proper utilization of resources so that both time and cost of road construction can be brought down. At the outset Shri Gadkari also thanked all the officials for having contributed immensely to the country's progress in the last two years. He added that while it was not possible to be perfect he wanted everyone to work upon their weaknesses and move forward. While speaking about the problem of land acquisition, he said that following the Land Acquisition Act of 2013, though the cost of land had gone up it had made the process of acquiring land smoother due to adequate compensation. He called upon states to streamline the process of giving compensation.

With regard to managerial skills, he emphasised to need to have appropriate persons for the appropriate job.

He also said that to speed up projects, it was necessary to increase the power of R.O.s and PDs. But, he added that while he was in favour of delegating powers there was an utmost need for performance audit at various levels to check delays. The Minister for Road Transport also felt that there was a need to work on reducing accidents and road fatalities. The rectification work at identified black spots need to be done urgently. Shri Gadkari also said that he would like to speed up the work on road side amenities on waste lands.

The Minister for State Shri Pon Radhakrishnan who also spoke during the inauguration said that roads are the second biggest infrastructure after power and that the hybrid annuity model could take development further. He also said that non-disbursement of funds and lack of updation of revenue records leads to delay in land acquisition.

The Secretary for Ministry of Road

Transport and Highways Shri Sanjay Mitra while addressing the gathering said that his Ministry would work hard to achieve the steep targets set for the year 2016-17. He said that efforts would be made to delegate powers so that projects could be speeded up. Besides, attention would be given to streamlining processes but only after necessary consultation.

The Chairman for NHAI, Shri Raghav Chandra informed that during the year 2015-16, 9,285 hectares of land had been acquired. He also proposed to provide incentives to Competent Authority for Land Acquisition (CALA) and District authorities to incentivize them to speed up the process of land acquisition.

On the occasion the Minister also released an online project monitoring system. A Compendium of Land Acquisition Circulars: Provisions and Guidelines has also been prepared and was made available to all participants of the conference.

Promotion/Transfer on deputation

Officers of the Central Govt. State Govt./Union Territories Administration :-

1. (a) holding analogous posts on regular basis; or
- (b) (i) with 2 years regular service in posts in the grade of Rs. 9300-34800+GP 4200 or
- (b) (ii) with 7 years regular service in posts in the scale of Rs. 5400-20200+GP 2800 or equivalent; and possessing the following qualifications and experience:-

Essential

- (i) Knowledge of the Motor Vehicles Act with up to date amendments and rules framed there under.
- (ii) Relevant filed experience.
- (iii) Knowledge of Malayalam.
- (iv) Must have attended a Government recognized training/programme/course in Motor Vehicle Inspection.

Note : In case a candidate does not possess this qualification (Sl. No. iv), he/she shall acquire it within 6 months of being appointed to the post, as may be provided by the competent authority.

2. The departmental Assistant Motor Vehicle Inspectors with 7 years regular service in the grade are also to be considered and in case he is selected for appointment to the post, the post shall be deemed to have been filled by promotion.
3. The department officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation.
4. Similarly, deputationist shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

BSNL, MTNL improve their financial conditions under current govt: Prasad

New Delhi : Communication and Information Technology Minister Ravi Shankar Prasad today said that the BSNL and MTNL which were loss making telecom companies in the past, have improved their financial conditions under the current government. Replying to supplementaries in the Lok Sabha, Mr. Prasad said that BSNL which had reported over 10 thousand crore rupees profit in 2004-05, incurred a loss of over eight thousand crore rupees in 2014-15. He said, BSNL has earned an operating profit of 672 crore rupees and its income form services has grown up by 4.16 per cent. On MTNL,

the Minister informed that the company had incurred a loss of around 2900 crore rupees in 2014 and now it has earned a profit of nearly 25 crore rupees. He said, the government is committed to improving the financial condition of the two companies. On the issue of call drop, Mr. Prasad said, his Ministry has accorded high priority to quality services of these two companies. He said, over 94 thousand new Base Transceiver Stations are being installed in the country to improve the network connectivity. He also said, there is currently no proposal to merge BSNL and MTNL.

Panic button must in mobile phones by next year

New Delhi : From January 1 next year, all mobile phones sold in India will come with a panic button enabling users, especially women, to send out distress signals in case of an emergency. No mobile handset will be sold in India without the facility of identifying the location through Satellite based GPS from January 2018.

Shooting: Mairaj bags India's first silver at ISSF World Cup

New Delhi : Indian shooter Mairaj Ahmed Khan made a successful start to his campaign at the ISSF World Cup by winning a silver medal in men's skeet event in Rio de Janeiro.

Mairaj's feat gave India its first skeet medal at a World Cup. The 40-year-old Indian shooter finished with an overall tally of 14 in the gold medal match but lost out to Marcus Svensson of Sweden in a shoot off after the latter was also tied at 14.
